Course Objectives

Participants will be able to:

- ❑ Define abstinence in relation to sexual activity
- ❑ Be able to cite the differences between comprehensive sexuality education and abstinence-only education
- ❑ Teach about sexuality in a way that is comfortable for both teacher and student
- ❑ Identify the characteristics that run through examples of effective, comprehensive, curriculum-based sexuality programs.
- ❑ Identify the misinformation that often surrounds abstinence-only education.
- ❑ Identify the fear tactics often used within abstinence-only education.
- ❑ Know how the differences in race, culture, and sexual orientation affect the effectiveness of programming and lesson plans.
- ❑ Learn to define risk and protective factors and recognize them within your own classroom
